Considering a High Court's recent warning on the misuse of AI in legal proceedings, we want to make our position clear:

At Get SAFE, we never use AI to generate legal citations or advice.

Our tools are designed to support victims of financial crime by helping them organise evidence, understand rights, and communicate clearly—not to provide legal representation.

We strictly avoid fabrications, and all users are encouraged to verify facts through trusted legal sources or seek regulated legal advice where necessary.

Al can be a powerful force for good—but only when used transparently, ethically, and with human judgment. That's the standard we uphold.



When the system fails, the people rise.

- Tens of thousands affected by financial exploitation.
- Tens of billions lost with little redress.
- Many are left without legal support or representation.





Al as a force multiplier:


- Sorts complex evidence (emails, PDFs, transcripts)
- Detects deception and inconsistency
- Drafts persuasive redress submissions
- Offers trauma-informed support workflows





Built in Notion + Al


- Evidence vaults

- Al amplifies empathy, it doesn't replace it
- Peer mentors + tech = transformation
